Sugarloaf group fights PATH

A local group of citizens concerned with the preservation of Sugarloaf Mountain has recently asked 13 states and the District of Columbia to file a complaint with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, according to a news release from Sugarloaf Conservancy President Douglas Kaplan.

The group says that the proposed 275-mile Potomac-Appalachian Transmission Highline -- PATH -- project from Putnam County, W.Va., to Frederick County should be abandoned.
